

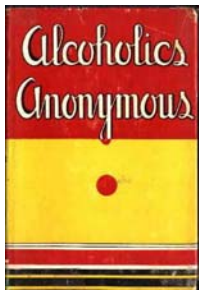
Big Book Study Weekend

October 14, 15, and 16, 2011

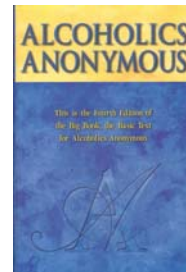
Hosted by District 9
